1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, THAT:**

2 1. **Judgment on Stricken Causes of Action.**

3 a. Pursuant to the SMS Order (October 13, 2023), as affirmed by the Decision
4 (August 14, 2025), the First Cause of Action in Plaintiff's April 3, 2023
5 Complaint is stricken with prejudice and judgment is hereby entered on the
6 First Cause Action in Defendants Garrett Ziegler and ICU, LLC (collectively,
7 "Defendants") favor and against Plaintiff P. Kevin Morris ("Plaintiff").

8 b. Pursuant to the Decision (August 14, 2025), the Second Cause of Action in
9 Plaintiff's April 3, 2023 Complaint is stricken with prejudice and judgment is
10 hereby entered on the Second Cause Action in Defendants' favor and against
11 Plaintiff.

12 2. **Effect of Plaintiff's Voluntary Dismissal.** The Third, Fourth, and Fifth Causes of
13 Action are dismissed without prejudice based solely on Plaintiff's March 19, 2026 voluntary
14 dismissal without prejudice.

15 3. **Attorney's Fees Award and Money Judgment.** Pursuant to the Court's order
16 following the March 19, 2026 hearing on Defendants' Motion for Attorney's Fees, Defendants are
17 awarded attorney's fees in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) and a money
18 judgment is entered in favor of Defendants and against Plaintiff P. Kevin Morris in the amount of
19 \$50,000.00, exclusive of any allowable costs.

20 4. **Costs.** Defendants are entitled to an award of costs in the amount of \$[_____].

21 5. **Entry of Judgment.** The Clerk is directed to enter this Judgment forthwith.
